MINUTE entry before the Honorable Thomas M. Durkin: The Court is in receipt of the stipulation [7273] and enters the following schedule regarding the Restaurants' Objection to the Direct Purchaser Plaintiff Class settlements with House of Raeford Farms and Koch. The Restaurants are to file their amended objection to the Settlements, not to exceed 30 pages, by 6/20/2024. The DPP Class is to file its response to the objection to the Settlements, not to exceed 30 pages, by 7/10/2024. HRF and Koch are to file a joint response to the objection, not to exceed 10 pages, by 7/10/2024. The Restaurants are to file a reply to the DPP Class response, not to exceed 10 pages, and a reply to the HRF and Koch response, not to exceed 5 pages, by 7/22/2024. Throughout the hearing, each speaker will be expected to identify themselves for the record before speaking. Counsel must be in a quiet area while on the line. Please be sure to keep your phone on mute when you are not speaking.
